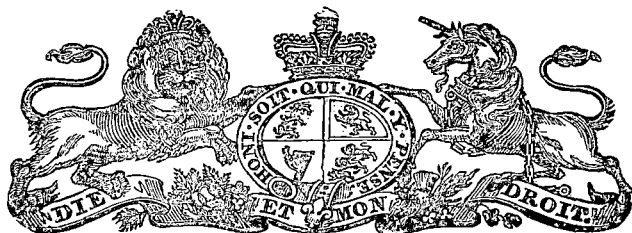

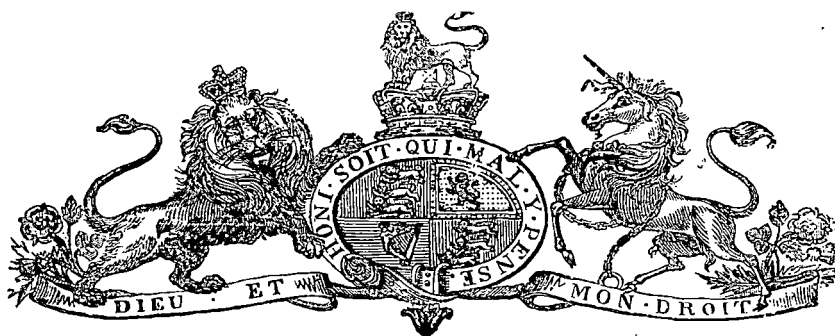

RETURN No. 4—*Showing the New Works constructed during the last Five Years, the Cost of each of such Works, and the Source from which the Amount was paid, and the proportionate Amount in each instance contributed by the other Colonies ; also the Amount now to the Credit of the Lighthouse Fund.*

1. Table Cape Light, £8085 10s. 2d., paid by Tasmanian Government.
2. Mersey Bluff Light and Mersey River Leading Lights, £3475 15s. 1d., paid by Tasmanian Government.
3. Eddystone Point Light, £22,529 7s. 5d., one-half of the cost paid by Tasmanian Government, and one-half by the Victorian Government.

The amount to the credit of the Lighthouse Fund on 30th September, 1889, including Cash in the Bank of Van Diemen's Land, Fixed Deposits, value of Oil and Stores on hand, and Money due by the Government, was £15,489 12s. 6d.
