



MINUTE No. 227.

The Governor in Council approves of the abolition of the present system of Classification of Government Officers and annual increase from the 30th June last, and of a fixed Salary being attached to every Office in the Civil Service from the 1st instant; every classified Officer now in the Public Service being allowed, as Compensation for the loss of such increase, the sum of £50, payable upon his quitting the Public Service, (provided he be not discharged therefrom for any misconduct), or such less amount as would have accrued to such Officer in the form of annual increase should he cease to belong to the Service before the aggregate amount reached the sum of £50.
