A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2005*

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2011*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Mental Health Amendment Act 2005** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 19 amended (Expiry)

Section 19(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “6 years and 6 months” and substituting “8 years and 6 months”.

5. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on the ninetieth day from the day on which it commences.
