- 1 The House met at Ten o'clock a.m.
- 2 PRAYERS. – The Speaker read Prayers.
- 3 QUESTIONS SEEKING INFORMATION. – In accordance with Standing Order No. 43, Questions without notice were asked.

- 4 PAPERS. – The Minister for Disability Services and Community Development laid upon the Table of the House the following Paper:-

- 5 BILL NO. 4. – The Premier presented -

A Bill for an Act to amend the Constitution Act 1934
