

CLAUSE NOTES
SUPPLY BILL (NO. 1) 2020

- Clause 1** This clause provides for the Short title of the Act to be the *Supply Act (No. 1) 2020*. This title makes it clear that the Act relates to 2020-21.
- Clause 2** This clause provides for the commencement of the Act from 1 July 2020. This commencement date facilitates the appropriation of the funds concerned for 2020-21.
- Clause 3** This clause provides for the interpretation of the terms Capital Services and Operating Services used in Schedule 1.
- Clause 4** This clause provides for the appropriation of \$3 019 438 000 out of the Public Account, to be applied for the services of the Government.
- Clause 5** This clause applies the sum of \$3 019 438 000 specified in Clause 4 for the purposes specified in Schedule 1.
- Clause 6** This clause states that the Treasurer must incorporate in the estimates of expenditure from the Public Account set out in the Bill for the ordinary Appropriation Act for the financial year ending on 30 June 2021 all money issued and applied, or to be issued and applied, under this Act as if that issue and application were to be appropriated afresh by that Act.
- Clause 7** This clause provides for the expiry of the Act on 30 June 2021.
