I am 93 years old and two weeks ago I fell and fractured my pelvis. An ambulance was called and took 3 hours to get to me, and I arrived in RHH at about 4.30pm. I was ramped until nearly midnight before being transferred to the Emergency Department proper. I was then taken to a ward at 4.00am! I have had a fortnight receiving wonderful care from Drs and nurses who were incredibly busy and stressed, working 12 hour shifts. Unfortunately they desperately needed to move me out of the hospital as they needed my bed, due to an overcrowded emergency department.

My family are now caring for me at home and we all share the view that healthcare should take priority over a football stadium and that the state cannot afford both!
