I am writing in response to your letter dated 23 January 2013 seeking information from questions on notice pertaining to a list of the non-expired category 2 and 8 sawlog contracts with Forestry Tasmania (FT) and includes the following detail:

- Volumes on contract,
- Expiry dates per contract, and
- Whether the contracts are compensable.

The responses below in Table 1 are from three Regional Sawmills who have remained nameless for the purpose of this exercise but have existing category 2 and category 8 wood supply contracts with FT. These three Mills are not the only holders of non-expired category 2 and category 8 contracts. There are some contract holders who have not provided information but we are confident all Tasmanian Sawmillers Association (TSA) members have been represented in this submission.
