ANSWER:


- This pilot is under the Housing portfolio and Minister Ellis.
- I am advised that Release of the Key Homes Key Worker Accommodation Pilot is a 3rd 100 Day election commitment.
- Homes Tasmania and State Growth, in consultation with the West Coast Council, are working to develop a pilot proposal for Government's consideration.
- This initiative provides an opportunity to explore potential housing options for DECYP employees on the west coast, and initial

conversations have been held with DECYP around these opportunities.
