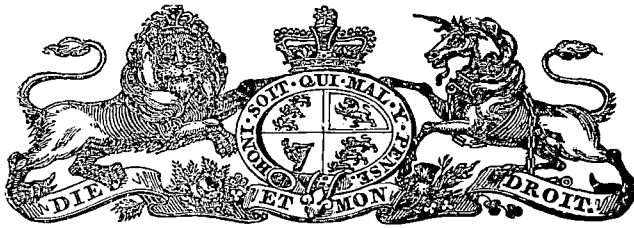

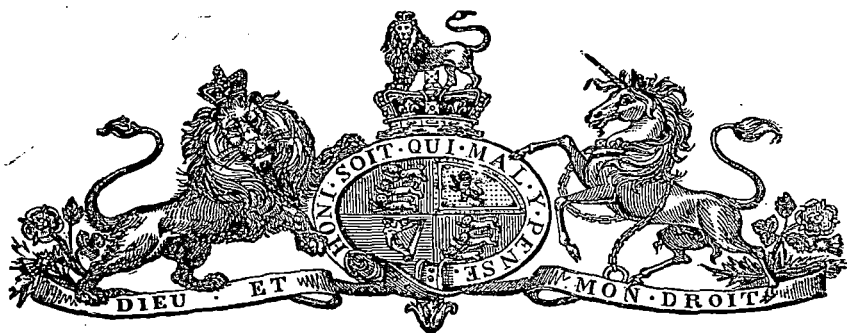

THE Governor in Council has been pleased, in accordance with the provisions of Section 12 of "The Fisheries Act, 1889," (53 Victoria, No. 11), to amend and approve of the following Regulation, the same having been made by the Commissioners of Fisheries, and published in accordance with Section 13 of the said Act.

REGULATION.

1. The taking of Seals, whether known by the name of Seals or any other local name, in Tasmania and its Dependencies is hereby prohibited for a period of Three years from the Twentieth day of July, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one; and any person committing any breach of this Regulation shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £5.
