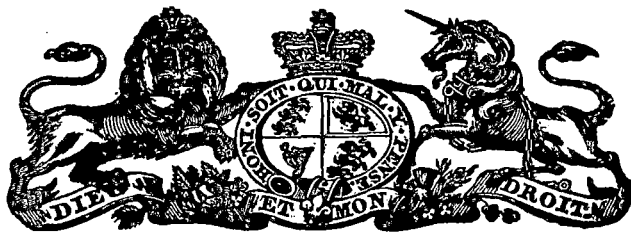

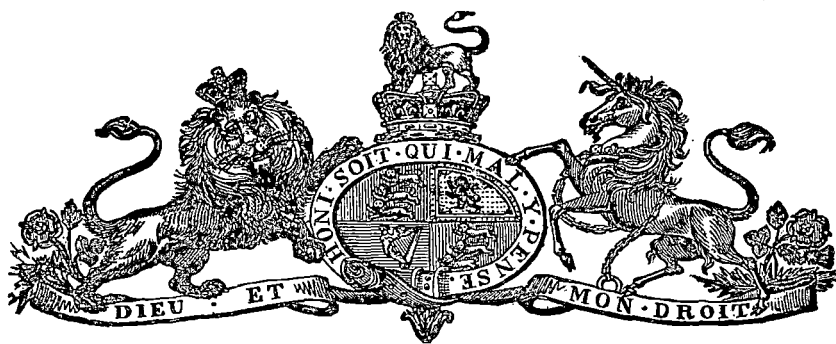

CIRCULAR HEAD MARINE BOARD.

BYE-LAW made by the Circular Head Marine Board under and by virtue of Acts of the Parliament of Tasmania, 21st Victoria, No. 16, and 31st Victoria, No. 30.

Bye-law 9.

Reduction in the Fees chargeable for Certificate of Exemptions to Duck River and Roblin's Passage.

That from and after the 1st day of July last past, 1877, the fee payable for Certificate of Exemption to Masters from Pilotage to be reduced from £5 to £3 per annum.

WHARFAGE RATES.

Reduction in the Rate per ton for Coal imported.

Be reduced from 1s. 3d. to 6d. per ton.

Anything contained in Bye-laws Nos. 3 and 7 to the contrary notwithstanding.

Made and passed by the Circular Head Marine Board, when the whole of the Members were present, this sixth day of June, 1878.
