# **CROWN LANDS (EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS) BILL 2003**

*(Brought in by the Minister for Primary Industries, Water and Environment, the Honourable Bryan Alexander Green)*

## **A BILL FOR**

### **An Act to extinguish public rights over certain land at East Devonport**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Extinguishment of Public Rights) Act 2003*.

#### **Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

#### **Extinguishment of public rights**

3. All public rights of way over all that land comprising 3 244 square metres, shown as Lot 1 on Survey Plan P 140000 filed and registered in the Office of the Recorder of Titles in Hobart, and being part of the Esplanade at East Devonport, are extinguished.

**Administration of Act**

**4.** Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990* –

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Primary Industries, Water and Environment; and
- (b) the department responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Primary Industries, Water and Environment.
