As a previous taxpayer and now a retiree I object to public funding going towards this project when thousands of Tasmanians can't get a home. I am at risk of losing my rental property as I only had a very small super and on my pension I pay over half of it on rent. I am a 67 yr old single female and we as a group have the highest number of homelessness figures in Australia and we need quickly constructed housing... Also there are more than 55,000 Tasmanians on the health waiting list to see a specialist and the cost of living is making life harder for more and more Tasmanians. How do we get your attention...

The AFL shouldn't be making Tasmanians pay for a new roofed stadium to have our own Tasmanian team. No other state has been made to do this. Tasmanians have not been consulted on the chosen site and I do not support the decision made by the government.

The government has not presented a business case that outlines the merits of this project or explained why our state should be burdened with further debt when the state already has two AFL standard stadiums, one in the north and one in the south that will now go to waste.

State priorities need to change. Housing and health solutions for lower paid workers and retirees without super should be the priority.

Another stadium is the wrong priority for our state.
