REPORT

THE Standing Committee on Public Accounts has the honour to present the following Report:

DEVONPORT MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

This was an application for a loan of £17,000 for lighting purposes. Mr. J. H. Butters, Chief Engineer and General Manager of the Hydro-Electric Department, appeared and presented a Report on the said proposal, and the application is recommended to the favourable consideration of your Honourable House, provided provision is made for a sinking fund of 1 per cent.

ULVERSTONE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

This application was for a loan of £3,000 for lighting purposes, and was also reported upon by Mr. J. H. Butters. It is recommended for favourable consideration, subject to a sinking fund of I per cent.
