Only partially employed to look after Loone's Contract, Patersonia and Ringarooma Road, which work has been completed. The Contractor, however, is bound to keep and maintain the road in good order to 31st December; and Cunningham has been employed at a rate of 12s. per diem, and an allowance for horse hire, to visit the works each fortnight till the date stated. Also, occasionally employed to inspect works, Piper's River, George's Bay, and Waterhouse. He will not be even temporarily required after the 31st December, 1871.
