work has been completed. The Contractor, how-
ever, is bound to keep and maintain the road in
good order to 31st December; and Cunningham
has been employed at a rate of 12s. per diem, and
an allowance for horse hire, to visit the works
each fortnight till the date stated. Also, occa-
sionally employed to inspect works, Piper's River,
George's Bay, and Waterhouse. He will not be
even temporarily required after the 31st December,
1871.
