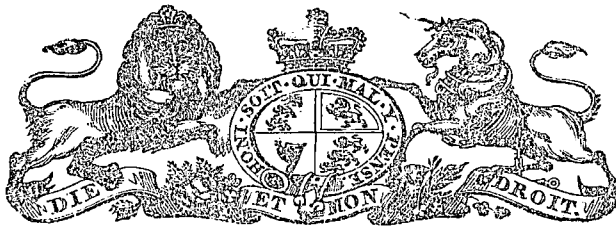

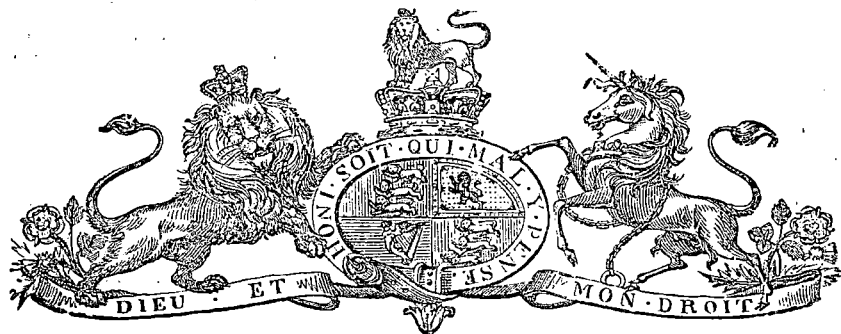

THE sum of £3,000, provided by *Loan's Bill*, 24 Vict. No. 38 under the head of Service, "Watch-houses throughout the territory," was voted for the erection of Watch-houses and Police Buildings—in accordance with a Return furnished to the Legislature at the time the Vote was taken—at the following places:—
