2 REPORT OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE 'B' ON THE INQUIRY INTO BLUEBERRY RUST IN TASMANIA.— Mr *Dean* presented a Report of the Legislative Council Government Administration Committee "B" into Blueberry Rust in Tasmania, together with evidence taken by the Committee.
