- **2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE.** The President said: "We meet today on Tasmanian Aboriginal land. We acknowledge and pay respect to the Tasmanian Aboriginal people and elders, past and present. We recognise them as the traditional and original owners and the continuing custodians of this land."
- **PRAYERS.** The President read Prayers.
- **4 PAPERS.** The Clerk of the Council laid upon the Table the *Public Health Act 1997:* Statutory Rules 2022, No. 15, containing Public Health (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2022.
- **5 BILL NO. 9.** The Youth Justice Amendment (Searches in Custody) Bill 2022 was read the Third time and passed.
- **6 BILL NO. 9.** A Message to the House of Assembly:—

The Legislative Council has this day agreed, without Amendment, to a Bill intituled, 'A Bill for an Act to amend the Youth Justice Act 1997 and to repeal section 19 of the Youth Justice (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2013'.
