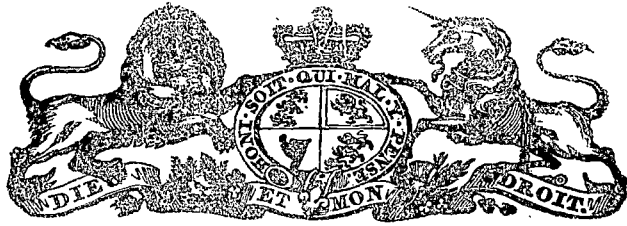

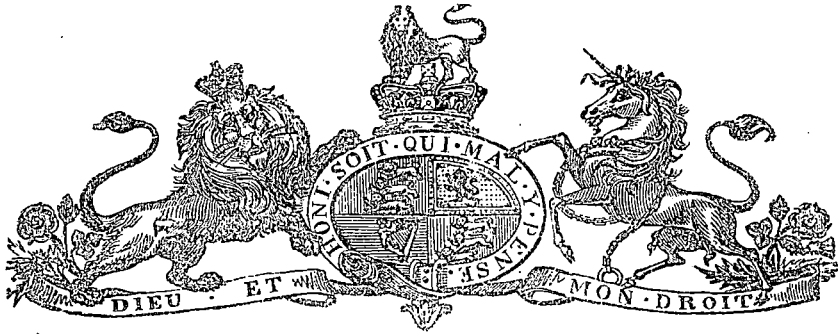

Laid upon the Table by the Minister of Lands and Works, and ordered by the House to be printed, September 15, 1876.



HOBART TOWN MARINE BOARD.

BYE-LAW No. 10.

If the Master of any Vessel not exempt from Pilotage arriving at or off the Port of Hobart Town hoists or shows the Flag referred to in the Seventy-second Section of the Marine Board Act, indicating that such vessel is exempt from Pilotage, he shall forfeit a penalty not exceeding Fifty Pounds.

Made and passed by the Hobart Town Marine Board, when a majority in number of the Wardens were present, this twenty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six.
