The House of Assembly hath passed a Bill, intituled — ‘A Bill for an to amend the *Duties Act 2001*, the *First Home Owner Grant Act 2000*, the *HomeBuilder Grants Act 2020* and the *Payroll Tax Rebate (Apprentices, Trainees and Youth Employees) Act 2017*’,
to which the House desires the concurrence of the Legislative Council.

- 5 BILL NO. 55 OF 2021.**— A Message from the House of Assembly:—

The House of Assembly doth agree to the Amendments made by the Legislative Council, to the Bill intituled, ‘An Act to encourage the diversion of waste from landfill, increase the recovery of resources from waste, impose a levy on waste received at a landfill facility and provide for a rebate in relation to that levy in certain circumstances, provide for standards and guidelines to be made in relation to landfill and resource recovery facilities, establish the Tasmanian Waste and Resource Recovery Board, and for related purposes’.
