The Aboriginal Land Council of Tasmania, the statutory body established under the Act and empowered to hold title of returned land on behalf of the Aboriginal community, formally responded to a 2021 State of the State invitation from then-Premier Gutwein to 'receive and consider land return proposals.' It formally proposed the return of the World heritage-listed land as a ground-breaking new tenure, an Aboriginal-owned kooparoona niara National Park. The Land Council has written to previous-Premier Gutwein twice, and to current Premier Rockliff once to put and reiterate this formal land claim. Why has no response been made to these three pieces of correspondence from the Aboriginal Land Council of Tasmania which make a formal proposal for land return? (MW)
