



House of Assembly Select Committee on the performance, governance and ownership
structure of Government businesses

Resolution

On Wednesday 12 March 2025, the House of Assembly –

Ordered – That the House:—

Establishes a Select Committee, with the power to send for persons, papers and records, to inquire into and report upon the potential sale of Government businesses and other entities, with the following terms of reference and rules:—

- (a) that the Committee inquire into and report upon the following:—
 - (i) the Tasmanian Government's plans to sell government businesses and other entities, and the potential impacts including on employees;
 - (ii) the current performance of Government businesses, including governance, financial outcomes, capital delivery and their contribution to Tasmania's broader economic objectives; and
 - (iii) any other matters incidental thereto.
- (b) that the Committee consist of six members: two nominated by the Premier, two nominated by the Leader of the Opposition, one nominated by the Leader of the Tasmanian Greens, and the Member for Braddon, Mrs Beswick.
- (c) that the Committee report by 1 February 2026.
