



MEETING OF JUSTICES, held at Fingal, for the District of Fingal, on the 9th day of December, 1861, at the Court House, Fingal, for the purpose of correcting and revising the Valuation Roll of the said District.

Proposed by Mr. Grant, seconded by Mr. Groom-" That Mr. Stuart take the Chair."

Mr. Stieglitz proposed—"That the Meeting do at once adjourn; and that, from the change of the value of Property, instead of revising the present Valuation Roll, Assessors be at once appointed to make a re-valuation of the Property of the District." The Proposition was Negatived.

Mr. Grant proposed—"That, in consequence of the depreciation of the produce of Agricultural and Dairy Lands of at least 50 per cent., and Township Property to an equal amount,—a corresponding reduction ought to be made in the valuation of such Properties; but that Sheep and Grazing Lands be not reduced." Mr. Groom seconded; the Proposition was adopted.

The Valuation Roll was revised and corrected accordingly.
