In respect of the financial year ending 30 June 2020, the payment out of the Public Account of the sum of five billion, fifty three million, nine hundred and seventy four thousand dollars (\$5 053 974 000) for the purposes set forth in Schedule 1 to the Appropriation Bill (No. 1) 2019.

In respect of the financial year ending 30 June 2020, the payment out of the Public Account of the sum of thirty four million dollars (\$34 000 000) for the purposes set forth in Schedule 1 to the Appropriation Bill (No. 2) 2019.
