- 4. Letters Patent read by the Clerk of the Council.
- 5. Senior Commissioner declares open the Second Session of the Fiftieth Parliament.
- 6. The Speaker, Clerk and Members of the House of Assembly leave the Chamber.
- 7. President acknowledges traditional people.
- 8. President reads Prayers.
- 9. The Leader of the Government presents the Bill, pro forma.
- 10. President calls for Petitions, Notice of Question, Notice of Motion and the Tabling of Papers.
- 11. The Leader of the Government makes statement concerning Ministerial Appointments.

- 12. President to authorize Advisers to the Leader of the Government and the Deputy Leader and Minister for Primary Industries and Water, the Minister for Disability Services and Minister for Women to go onto the Floor of this House.
- 13. Leader of the Government to seek leave to move various Motions without Notice.
- 14. Leader of the Government to move for Sessional Committee appointments. [Joint House Committee and Joint Library Committee].
- 15. Leader of the Government to move for the continuation of Sessional Orders relating to E-Petitions.
- 16. Leader of the Government to move for the continuation of Sessional Orders in lieu of Standing Orders Nos. 29(2), 138(2) and (4).
- 17. Leader of the Government to move for the continuation of Sessional Order in lieu of Standing Order No. 200.
- 18. Leader of the Government to move for the suspension of so much of Standing Order No. 39 so as to enable Special Interest Matters to be called on each sitting Tuesday before Notices of Motion and Orders of the Day are proceeded with.
- 19. Leader of the Government to move for the suspension of the sitting at 4 o'clock p.m. on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for 30 minutes.
- 20. Leader of the Government to move for the resumption of the proceedings on the State of the State Address take note debate.
- 21. Leader of the Government to move for the restoration to the Notice Paper of four Orders of the Day concerning the consideration and noting of four Public Accounts Committee Reports.
- 22. Leader of the Government to move for the reappointment of Deputy Chairs of Committees.
