1 The House met at Ten o'clock a.m.

2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL PEOPLE. - The Speaker made a statement acknowledging the traditional people of the land.

3 PRAYERS AND REFLECTION. – The Speaker read Prayers.

4 QUESTIONS SEEKING INFORMATION. – In accordance with Standing Order No. 43, Questions without notice were asked.

5 PAPERS. – The Minister for Primary Industries and Water laid upon the Table of the House the following Papers:-

- (1) Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995: Fisheries (Processing and Handling) Amendment Rules 2020 (Statutory Rules 2020, No. 81).
- (2) Land Acquisition Act 1993 (Notice of Acquisition pursuant to Section 18): Dated 17 February 2021, land situate in Parish of Wells, Land District of Devon, Municipal Area of West Tamar, Lot 1 on Plan of Survey P180006 registered in the name of John Odin Wentworth for road purposes.
- 6 PAPERS. The Minister for Local Government laid upon the Table of the House the following Papers:-Local Government Act 1993:
 - (*a*) West Tamar Council: Reserves, Parks and Gardens By-Law 1 of 2021;
