Joint Sessional Committee on Gender and Equality

Friday, 24 January 2024

The Joint Sessional Committee on Gender and Equality will conduct a Public Hearing for the purpose of an inquiry into the gender and equality impacts of the proposed payment of compensation in the Expungement of Historical Offences Bill 2024.

The Committee will conduct the public hearing on Tuesday, 28 January next. A schedule of those appearing before the Committee is attached.

On 20 November 2024 the Joint Sessional Committee on Gender and Equality received the following referral from the Legislative Council: -

"That the Expungement of Historic Offences Amendment Bill 2024 be referred to the Joint Sessional Committee on Gender and Equality for consideration and report on matters related to gender and equality impacts of the proposed payment of compensation under the Bill."
