## Workplace Culture Oversight

### MEETING COMMUNIQUE

**Thursday, 25 September 2025**

The Joint Sessional Committee on Workplace Culture Oversight (the Committee) was reestablished by joint resolution in the Fifty-Second Parliament following the prorogation of the Fifty-First Parliament and dissolution of the House of Assembly (Proclamations issued 11 June 2025 by Her Excellency the Governor) due to the calling of an early general State Election which meant committee activity ceased from 11 June 2025.

On Thursday, 25 September 2025 the Committee held its first meeting to formally re-establish the Committee. The Independent Member for Murchison, the Hon Ruth Forrest MLC was re-elected Chair and the Committee discussed its future program.

The Committee is scheduled to meet next on **Monday, 20 October at 1:00 pm** with Mr Andrew Young to receive an update on the project.

The Committee notes the importance of this review and encourages employees across each employee group to become fully informed and engaged to collectively work towards providing a better workplace for all employees.

The Committee further notes that change can be challenging and commits to providing ongoing updates to inform all interested parties.
