 - (2) Land Tax Act 2000: Statutory Rules 2019, No. 3, containing Land Tax (Exemption Extension) Order 2019.
- **3 BILL NO. 4.** The Motor Accidents (Liabilities and Compensation) Amendment Bill 2019 was read the Third time and passed.
- **4 BILL NO. 4.** A Message to the House of Assembly:—
