Inquiry into Built Heritage Tourism in Tasmania

The Legislative Council Government Administration Committee B has recently formed a Sub-Committee to conduct an inquiry into the current and potential future contribution of built heritage to tourism in Tasmania. The Inquiry will examine the role of Government and tourism and heritage organisations in the marketing, promotion and management of built heritage tourism in Tasmania, and will include consideration of models from other jurisdictions.
