say the high turnover of visitors particularly
over the warmer months does nothing for the
amenity of the neighbourhood.

Parking (one house accommodates 8 adults
plus extra children so lots of poorly parked
hire cars are needed) causes homeowners
and their visitors some consternation & inconvenience
Waste management is another problem. I have
discovered meat & takeaway food and used
utensils and used unwrapped disposable
nappies in my green waste bin on one
occasion. Perhaps some stickers in other
languages could be considered. I have
met people in my garden picking flowers.
I have had people ringing my doorbell at
night looking for their friends who are staying
somewhere in the street at one of the ss
rentals.
