

FACT SHEET

Supply Bill (No. 1) 2024

- The 2024-25 Budget is scheduled for release on 12 September 2024.
- 2024 Supply Acts are required to be in place by 30 June 2024 to enable agencies to meet the cost of delivering Government services in 2024-25, until the passing of the 2024 Appropriation Bills
- Supply Bill (No. 1) 2024 seeks to appropriate \$3 499.6 million for the services of the Government for the 2024-25 financial year.
- The sum to be appropriated by this Bill reflects the estimated funding required to enable the continuation of Government services for a period of up to five months, to 30 November 2024.
- The sum has been determined with reference to actual agency expenditure for the first five months of 2023-24, the revised 2024-25 estimates as presented in the *2023-24 Revised Estimates Report*, and consultation with relevant agencies.
- The sum for the supply period also includes an allocation to ensure relevant agencies have sufficient funding to continue the implementation of the Government's response to the recommendations of the *Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings* during the supply period. The allocation has been determined by the Department of Premier and Cabinet in consultation with the Children and Youth Safety and Wellbeing Secretaries Board.
