FACT SHEET

Supply Bill (No. 1) 2024

- The 2024-25 Budget is scheduled for release on 12 September 2024.
- 2024 Supply Acts are required to be in place by 30 June 2024 to enable agencies to meet the
 cost of delivering Government services in 2024-25, until the passing of the 2024 Appropriation
 Bills
- Supply Bill (No. 1) 2024 seeks to appropriate \$3 499.6 million for the services of the Government for the 2024-25 financial year.
- The sum to be appropriated by this Bill reflects the estimated funding required to enable the continuation of Government services for a period of up to five months, to 30 November 2024.
- The sum has been determined with reference to actual agency expenditure for the first five months of 2023-24, the revised 2024-25 estimates as presented in the 2023-24 Revised Estimates Report, and consultation with relevant agencies.
- The sum for the supply period also includes an allocation to ensure relevant agencies have sufficient funding to continue the implementation of the Government's response to the recommendations of the Commission of Inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's Responses to Child Sexual Abuse in Institutional Settings during the supply period. The allocation has been determined by the Department of Premier and Cabinet in consultation with the Children and Youth Safety and Wellbeing Secretaries Board.
