

Short inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's response to serious allegations within harness racing

The House of Assembly Standing Committee on Government Administration B has resolved to conduct a short, targeted inquiry into the Tasmanian Government's response to serious allegations within harness racing, with reference to the following:

- 1) The Murrihy Review;
- 2) The Independent Stewards Report;
- 3) Licensing and warning off of participants;
- 4) The performance of the Office of Racing Integrity; and
- 5) Any other matters incidental thereto.

The Committee will invite specific persons or organisations to make written submissions and give evidence, and at this point the inquiry is not open to public submissions.
