It has been only in severe weather events that any waser has imposed on the road & then in the very low lying areas only. mese grassed verges have been essential for safe movement of stock, form machinery , sh cases of emorgancies such at breakdowns, Plant type cete. Ditches were put into these low lying orders which we completely understand but the grise acceptable spoon drain that has been put along the sides of the complete new section has now blecome à sizeable ditch soo as the new highway all sign is to build the road up with laight upon layer of growel to quite on in creased keight. Although the road is now a lovely surface, which is good there is no shoulder or verge at all which we feel is not safe. Safety should be the primary concern and we feel this is very much Compromised as There is no room for any errors of judgement when trucks pass through at considerable speed Many feel frustrated that this has happened just in months since the new section of the litessy Longford road works project as the same concerns were raised by many then, In tact I rang State Grown to discuss The concerns when it become obvious that the height of the road was oreasing the same Situation of having no verge to veer off on when needing oversized nowhing which Hequent these roads. I also brought to her assention These were no run offs for the school buses which Stop at various places along this road.
