QUESTION:

Recently, I was in Oatlands and talking to a few of the locals about health services available in the region. One of them asked me when the Oatlands ambulance station would be completed. Can you please provide an update on construction and when we can expect to see ambos move in?

ANSWER:

The Tasmanian Liberal Government is continuing to deliver the critical infrastructure our paramedics need to provide high-quality care to Tasmanians, right around the State.

Construction on the new \$2.75 million Oatlands Ambulance Station commenced in early March 2024 and is expected to be complete by late January 2025.

Following the usual commissioning period, the station is expected to be operational and welcome paramedics and volunteers in February 2025.

The state-of-the-art station will have two bays for ambulances, training room facilities, dedicated areas to improve compliance with infection control requirements, and improved general amenities for all users.
