# EDUCATION (RETENTION OF SCHOOLS) BILL 2011

*(Brought in by Michael Darrel Joseph Ferguson MP)*

## A BILL FOR

### **An Act to provide for the retention of certain schools.**

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### **1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Education (Retention of Schools) Act 2011*

#### **2. Commencement**

This Act commences on the day on which it received the Royal Assent.

#### **3. Retention of certain schools**

Notwithstanding section 18(2) of the Education Act 1994, it is the duty of the Minister administering that Act to ensure that the schools specified in Schedule 1 will remain open and that students will continue to be taught at them until 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014.

#### **4. Retrospective Application of this Act**

In the event that the Minister administering the Act makes a decision under s18(2) of the Education Act 1994 to close any school specified in Schedule 1, between 16<sup>th</sup> June 2011 and this Act receiving Royal Assent, then that decision shall be reversed.
