Please note the following:

Fallow deer abound in reserves of the Mole Creek Karst National Park, including the TWWHA.

There should be strong priority given to controlling deer in reserved lands generally.

However, there is great need for the control of deer on the Great Western Tiers and karstlands abutting the Central Plateau in order to facilitate recovery from drought and bushfire.

Reduction of deer that aims for eradication from reserved lands would improve resilience of reserved lands to further climatic insults of climate change.
