I wish to make this request to the committee to make the following sections of road safer for cyclists and motorists.

The three uphill sections on the Margate to Sandfly road.

The top section of the hill on the Channel Highway between Conningham and Oyster Cove.

The safety lane on the Channel Highway between Taroona High School and the Truganina Reserve where parked cars force cyclists to move out on to the road.

I have been cycling on these roads for the last 40 years and although I've seen some excellent advances in making our roads safer e.g. Bonnet Hill safety lane, the railway crossing at Bryn Estyn, New Norfolk (which took me 2 years of petitioning!) I consider the above road sections are still very dangerous.
