1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Births*, *Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulations* 2019.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 5 September 2019.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations –

Act means the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1999.

4. Prescribed persons

For the purposes of section 46(3)(c) and (10) of the Act, the following persons are prescribed:

- (a) the spouse, or a former spouse, of the person to whom the birth certificate relates (the *registered person*);
- (b) a person who is, or has been, in a significant relationship, within the meaning of the *Relationships Act 2003*, with the registered person;
- (c) a parent of the registered person;
- (d) an executor or administrator of the registered person's estate;
- (e) a person who holds a power of attorney in respect of the registered person;
- (f) an agent of the registered person who has the written consent of the registered person;
- (g) an officer or person acting on behalf of a court, or a law enforcement body, of the State, another State, a Territory or the Commonwealth.

5. Fees

- (1) The fees set out in Schedule 1 are prescribed as the fees that are payable under the Act in respect of the matters to which they respectively relate.
- (2) The Registrar and a person who asks for a service that is not referred to in Schedule 1 may negotiate and fix the fee that is payable by the person for the service.

6. Legislation rescinded

The legislation specified in Schedule 2 is rescinded.
